Q – May I bring my spouse or children to the three-day retreat?

A – No. There are only 120 spots for attendees. Everyone who attends must be registered for this exclusive event. Daughters age 12 or older are welcome!

Q – Is there an age requirement for registering for Karen's retreat?

A – Attendees must be at least 21 to stay at The Harpeth hotel by themselves. Attendees must be at least 12 to attend Karen's retreat.

Q – Will Karen's women's retreat be available online?

A – No. This exclusive retreat is interactive and in-person only.

Q – What is the dress code for Karen's retreat?

A – Casual. Please dress comfortably, the way you would dress when hanging out with girlfriends.

Q – May I share a room at The Harpeth with another attendee?

A – Yes, all rooms are double occupancy. The cost for the first person in the room is \$1799. The 2nd person's registration cost is \$1399. The two of you can work out splitting this cost.

Q – Can I make payments?

A – Yes! You may make monthly payments. If you miss the monthly payment deadlines, your spot may be given to someone on our waiting list. If that happens, you would be refunded all but a \$200 convenience fee. If there is no waiting list, you run the risk of losing your money. (See refund policy)

Q – What is your refund policy?

A – Our policy is different from the hotel’s policy. If you choose The Harpeth hotel retreat option, you will be purchasing rooms from Karen’s Belong team. The refund policy is this: You have 4 days after registering to request a refund for your deposit – no questions asked. We expect this event to sell out quickly.

Therefore, with your registration we will hold a spot for you. So after the four-day period, there are no refunds except in the case of a doctor-verified illness. Please do not attend if you are exhibiting symptoms of Covid-19 or any other illness. Refunds may take up to six weeks to process after receiving a note from your doctor.

Q – What are your Covid-19 policies?

A – Franklin, Tennessee is in Williamson County, where there is no mask mandate. Masks are not required for this intensive when in our meeting space. We encourage you to wear a mask to protect yourself if you are concerned about illness.

Q – May I videotape Karen’s exclusive retreat?

A – No. Video and audio recording is not allowed at the retreat.

Q – Are meals included in the retreat?

A – The welcome dinner is included for all attendees. The three-day retreat will also include morning coffee from Nashville’s favorite Honest Coffee Roasters (regular and decaf) ... and a sampling of Nashville’s famous local snacks each evening. Water will be provided throughout each session. Outside food and beverages are not allowed in the meeting room, but they are allowed in the hotel common areas

Q – I’m considering staying at The Harpeth hotel. How many attendees may stay at this property?

A – If you are interested in staying at The Harpeth, please register as soon as possible. We expect these rooms to sell out quickly.

A – Yes, you may. However, The Harpeth rooms booked outside the intensive are very expensive. Karen is giving you a discount on the hotel rooms. You are paying less than her cost.

Q – May I upgrade my accommodations to one of The Harpeth hotel suites?

A – If you are interested in a room upgrade, let us know as soon as possible. Karen's team will do all they can to help you make this happen, depending on availability.

Q – May I bring my pet to the intensive?

A – No. Only if the pet is a registered service animal. There is an additional \$100 fee for this. Be sure to tell us at registration if this applies to you.

Q – Does The Harpeth allow smoking?

A – No. The Harpeth hotel is 100% smoke free.

Q – May I add additional nights to my time at The Harpeth, should I choose that type registration?

A – Yes! Based on availability, you may add up to four nights before and/or after the retreat. If you do this, be sure to go through Karen, as her team will get you a significant discount for these additional nights.

Q – Can I attend just for one day for a lower price?

A – No. If you can only attend one day, that's fine. But the cost remains the same.
